It is our goal to keep all procedure as reasonably priced as possible. Our base price includes the services that we feel are the most important for a successful surgery and comfortable experience for your pet. There are several other services that we feel are important to offer.

General Information Regarding Anesthesia:

Anesthesia – We use the same safe Isoflurane gas that is often used in human medicine. Isoflurane is primarily eliminated through the respiratory tract rather than through the kidneys or liver. This helps to reduce the risk associated with anesthesia and allows for a quicker recovery

Pre Anesthetic Blood Testing – Our on-site laboratory lets us screen for hidden problems before your pet's treatment begins. Or we can use an off-site laboratory to run a very thorough test of approximately 35 different things, including a CBC for anemia and white blood cell problems, testing for liver, kidney, electrolyte problems, diabetes, thyroid levels and many other things.

* This test is strongly recommended for animals over 7years old and required on animals 10years or old.

Micro-chipping: This is a form of permanent identification that can identify your pet if they are lost, run away, are stolen, or are otherwise separated from you (such as following an emergency evacuation). Our microchip includes free registration. Our regular price for the microchip is \$39.45, if it is done today under anesthesia there is a \$10.00 savings- **\$29.45**

Retained canine tooth extraction: Sometimes, baby teeth in the puppy do not fall out on their own and need to be extracted. If not extracted, retained canine teeth can lead to crowding, malposition of teeth or abnormal bite.
- **\$45.00 per retained tooth.**

In order to prevent the spread of infectious disease, I authorize Pet Lovers Animal Hospital to administer a rabies vaccine, and/or flea or tick medication to my pet, at my expense, if deemed necessary.

I certify that I own the above described animal and authorize the Pet Lovers Animal Hospital to hospitalized said animal. During this time they may administer vaccinations, medication, tests, surgical procedures, anesthesia, or treatments they deem necessary for the health, safety, and well being of my pet while under the care and supervision of the hospital. I understand that there are inherent risks associated with anesthesia, medical and surgical procedures, including death. I authorize the doctors of the Pet Lovers Animal Hospital to initiate care to address these complications should they arise while under their care. In the event of an emergency, the hospital will make every reasonable attempt to contact me so that I am aware of the situation, so that I am involved in medical decision. The contact phone numbers in the chart are correct. If my pet should injure itself in an escape attempt, refuse food, soil itself, become ill, or die while in the hospital, I will not hold the Pet Lovers Animal Hospital and staff any of all responsibility and/or liability. I understand that veterinarian in charge. Continuous presence of qualified personnel may not be provided.

I further realize that I am responsible for payment of all above mentioned procedures/treatments in full at the time of my pet is discharged. If I neglect to pick up the animal within 14days of notice that it is ready for release, the Animal Hospital assume that the animal has been abandoned. In such instance, the Animal Hospital id then authorized to take care of my pet as they see fit, including euthanasia and adoption. Abandonment, however, does not release me of my obligation for payment of said bill.

I further agree that in case of non-payment, to pay a finance charge of 1.5 percent per month (18percent per annum), a \$2.00 month billing charge and any and all collection and attorney's fees incurred by the Pet Lovers Animal Hospital relating to this manner.
